

# Guidelines for the passport and suitcase

## Groups 1 to 4

Preparation: Make sure you have sufficient advertising brochures.

### Passports

1. Print the passport on an A4 sheet of paper.
2. Cut off the white print margin around the passport.
3. Fold the page over in the middle.
4. Glue the blank reverse sides to one another.
5. Fold the halved page once again in the middle.
6. The passport is ready to be filled in.

Two versions of the passport are available:

A full-colour version, with the front and back pages in colour (colour printer).

A black-and-white version, with the front and back pages to be coloured in.



### Suitcase

1. Print the suitcase out on an A4 sheet of paper.
2. Cut out the flags.
3. The children can colour in the flags and stick them on the suitcase.
4. Have the pupils cut out items from the advertising brochures that they would like to take on holiday with them (e.g. toothbrush, swimming trunks, etc.).
5. Have the pupils stick the items to the suitcase.

Two versions of the suitcase are available:

A full-colour version, with the suitcase in colour (colour printer).

A black-and-white version, with the suitcase and the flags to be coloured in.
